## ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

### MODERN AND CLASSICAL LANGUAGES

- Students participate in national exams in French and Latin, and National Honor Societies.
- Students compete in regional Certamen, a Latin culture and language trivia contest.
- The DELF Junior (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française), an internationally recognized diploma from the French Ministry of Education, is awarded to students who complete rigorous testing.

### SCIENCE

- Students engage in real world research and problem solving by collecting and analyzing data using ecological research skills to measure population density and biodiversity (eastern mudsnails, *Spartina alterniflora*, and ribbed mussels).
- In partnership with the University of Rhode Island, students monitor invasive species (Phragmites) and protect threatened species (the diamondback terrapin).

### FINE AND PERFORMING ARTS

- Students compete in the Rhode Island Scholastic Art Competition.
- Our fine arts teachers are working artists who exhibit and sell their work outside of Rocky Hill School.
- Rocky Hill School's Deckhands Theater Company partners with Trinity Repertory Company, whose educators share their pedagogical theater expertise with our students.

### MATHEMATICS

- The Robotics Team competes in the national FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) Tech Challenge. In back-to-back years, the team has made it to the state finals.

**NEW:** In 2018, students developed and participated in the first ever statewide energy Hackathon with global advisors, thought leaders, and state politicians.
